NEW MUSIC DIRECTOR FOR THE KU-RING-GAI MALE CHOIR



Following the retirement of Dr Paul Whiting OAM after 26 years of service to the Ku-ring-gai Male Choir as our Music Director and Conductor, the choir is excited to announce the appointment of Warren Fisher.

Warren started his working life in the classroom and as a conductor of bands and choirs.

His equal love of performance took him away from the classroom for over a decade, singing with among others Opera Afloat, The Three Irish Tenors, Pacific Opera, The Sydney Opera House Trust and Opera Australia where he has more than 36 operas to his credit.

With great joy he returned to the world of education where he took over the reins of the choir program at Knox Grammar School and is now Director of Choirs and Tech Crew Co-ordinator.

He strongly believes that everyone should sing. Not because it helps brain development, concentration skills, or literary and numeracy skills, but because everyone can do it.

"When we sing, we access areas of our being that may otherwise be left dormant; and it just feels so good," he says.

Warren is also the Artistic Director for "Celebration Sing Out !" which raises funds to provide music therapy for kids in hospital, and the Director of the Normanhurst Uniting Church Musical Society.

The Ku-ring-gai Male Choir has been active since 1946 and is one of the oldest choirs in Sydney.

We are thrilled at Warren's appointment as our new Music Director and Conductor, and will continue to grow and develop under his leadership.
